Position Summary:

A minimum of four years of progressive supervisory/management experience is required. Preference given to those with experience in law enforcement, criminal justice, military police or comparable industrial security fields. Patrol, and direct the patrol of the FMGC facilities and grounds for the purpose of detecting and preventing the occurrence of crimes and other security-related incidents. Direct the conduct of preliminary investigation of crimes and other security-related incidents. Comply with the Tribal Gaming Ordinance, the appendices of the Ordinance, FMGC Policies, and all Security Department Policies and Procedures. Coordinate and cooperate with other FMGC managers and employees, and local emergency services responding to incidents occurring on FMGC property. Perform any duties as directed by Security Department management.

Requirements:

- Ability to exercise sound leadership skills, good judgment, and to make logical decisions where tact and discretion are essential
- Good organization and communications skills are necessary
- Able and willing to work any shift and hours as assigned by Security Department management
- Physical requirements of the job may include prolonged periods of standing and walking
- High school diploma or GED required
- Valid Arizona driver's license required
- Good verbal and report writing skills required
- Must have excellent customer service skills with the ability to exercise sound judgment
- Make logical decisions in situations requiring tact and discretion

- Physical requirements may include ability to stand or walk for prolonged periods
- Must be able to lift 50 pounds and push or pull 100 pounds
- Must be able to obtain and maintain State/Tribal License (including extensive background check)
- Must pass pre-employment drug test
- Must be able to work in a casino (smoking) environment
- Must be 21 or older
